

# CANPASS REMOTE AREA BORDER CROSSING (RABC) PERMIT

#### THE CANPASS RABC PERMIT IS VALID FOR THE FOLLOWING REMOTE AREAS:

- from Pigeon River through to and including Lake of the Woods
- the Canadian shore of Lake Superior
- Cockburn Island
- Sault Ste. Marie (upper lock system)
- Emerson West Lynne

The CANPASS RABC permit, allows the bearer to cross the border into Canada at the above remote areas without reporting to a port of entry, as long as imported goods are declared.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR A CANPASS RABC PERMIT?

Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada, United States citizens and permanent residents of the United States are eligible to apply for a CANPASS RABC permit.

United States citizens and permanent residents must meet normal visitor legislative requirements, as described under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* (IRPA), that is, be in good health, be law abiding and have sufficient funds for their stay in Canada. Applicants may not qualify for a CANPASS RABC permit if they have been previously charged with a contravention of Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) or Immigration legislation; if they have criminal convictions for which there has not been a pardon or, if they have provided false or incomplete information on the CANPASS RABC permit application.

#### **PROGRAM CONDITIONS:**

- CANPASS RABC permits are valid only for the remote areas listed above and may not be used to cross the border at any other location.
- Individuals crossing at any other location in Canada should consult our Web site at www.cbsa-asfc.gc.ca to learn about an alternate reporting program for your area.
- Individuals must have their CANPASS RABC permit in their possession when they cross the border into Canada at the remote areas
  identified above. Individuals who are not in possession of a CANPASS RABC permit, or whose permit has expired must enter at a port of
  entry. Verifications will be conducted periodically.
- CANPASS RABC permit holders entering to work in Canada must be in possession of a valid work permit where applicable under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* (IRPA).
- CANPASS RABC permit holders entering at a CBSA office open for business will not be exempted from the normal examination process.
- Dependents travelling separately must have a copy of the CANPASS RABC permit in their possession.
- All firearms must be registered and presented to the CBSA at a port of entry prior to being brought into Canada. Forms are available at 1-800-731-4000, at www.cfc-ccaf.gc.ca or at any CBSA office. If you have any questions about importing a firearm into Canada, please check our Web site at www.cbsa-asfc.gc.ca or call the CBSA office nearest you.
- CANPASS RABC permit holders, who are importing goods that will remain in Canada, or who are importing goods over their personal
  exemption entitlement, must contact a CBSA office prior to departing from the United States and provide a full description and value of all
  such goods. A border services officer will issue a reference number to the CANPASS RABC permit holders and will advise them of the
  steps they must follow when they arrive in Canada.

# HOW TO APPLY FOR A CANPASS REMOTE AREA BORDER CROSSING (RABC) PERMIT

## SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

- **Passport:** submit a photocopy of the pages bearing your photograph and signature. No further documentation is required if you submit your passport.
- If you do not have a passport, each person 18 years and over **must** provide two pieces of identification: one primary **AND** one secondary document. Photocopies of identification documents are acceptable. **Do not** mail original documents.
- Each child under 18 years of age need only provide a primary document.
- Note: If you have received a CANPASS RABC permit in the last three years, you do not need to submit copies of identification. You will only need to submit identification for family members whose names have been added to the permit.

#### Documents that MUST be provided (primary documents):

- Passport (no secondary ID required)
- United States Permanent Resident Card
- State Issued Birth Certificate \*\*
- Canadian Permanent Resident Card
- Record of Landing (IMM 1000)
- Province Issued Birth Certificate
- Citizenship Card or Citizenship Certificate
- Certificate of Naturalization

## Documents that MAY be requested (secondary documents):

- Driver's License (preferred)
- United States Social Security Card
- Canadian Social Insurance Card

Note: \*\* Hospital certificates are **not** acceptable.

## PROCESSING FEE

#### By Mail:

- The CAN \$30 per application processing fee includes the principal applicant plus qualifying family members (see below).
- The processing fee is **NOT** refundable.
- CAN \$30 payable by Visa, MasterCard or American Express **ONLY**.

#### In person at a CBSA office:

- May be paid in cash, debit card, or a cheque drawn on a Canadian Financial Institution.
- Please note that cheques drawn on United States bank accounts are not acceptable.

#### QUALIFYING FAMILY MEMBERS

- The family consist of a principal applicant plus spouse (includes a common law partner or same sex partner who have lived with principal applicant for one or more years) and children under 18 years of age. Children under 18 must be children of the applicant, applicant's spouse or of legal guardianship to applicant.
- Please list all children under 18 years of age that may be travelling to Canada in the next year. Dependents cannot be added after the CANPASS RABC permit has been processed.

## **EXPIRY DATE INFORMATION**

• CANPASS RABC permits are valid for one year from the date of issue.

# WHERE TO APPLY FOR A CANPASS REMOTE AREA BORDER CROSSING (RABC) PERMIT

## **BY MAIL (PREFERRED METHOD)**

At least 3-4 weeks in advance of your trip, mail the completed application and photocopies of the supporting documentation to:

You will receive a response by mail, unless an interview is deemed necessary. You MUST have a copy of your CANPASS RABC permit on your person when travelling.

## IN PERSON

When applying in person, a decision will be provided while you wait, or mailed to you within 48 hours. Waiting times at ports of entry may vary. During peak travel times, line-ups can result in significant delays.
